INFORMATION

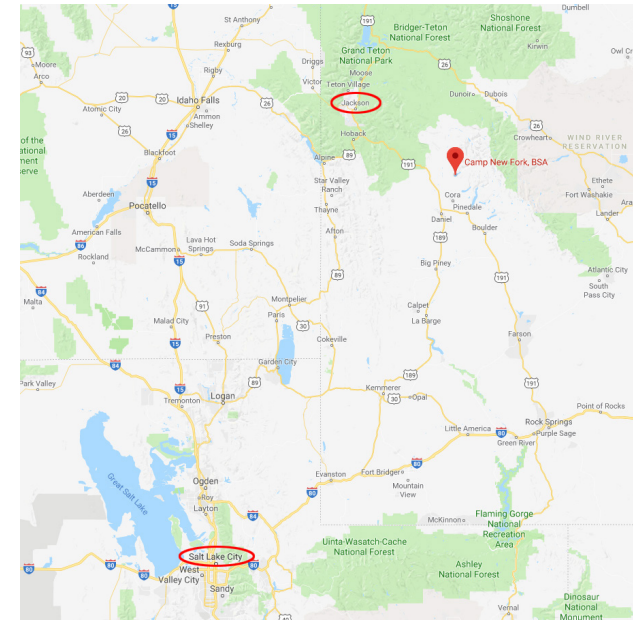
Hiking and camping without a trace are signs of an expert outdoorsman, and of a Scout or Scouter who cares for the environment. Leave No Trace is an awareness and an attitude rather than a set of rules. It applies in your backyard or local park as much as in the backcountry. We should all practice Leave No Trace in our thinking and actions—wherever we go.

The five-day Master Educator Course is the top tier of Leave No Trace training. This course provides participants with a comprehensive training on Leave No Trace skills and ethics with practical application during a field based course. Participants learn minimum impact techniques through methods including discussion, use of scenarios, and hands-on activities.

The Master Educator Course is also designed to prepare participants to be the best possible teachers of Leave No Trace in both a formal and informal setting. This is done by exploring and practicing various learning styles, effective communication techniques and by having the participants prepare and present a Leave No Trace lesson for their peers. Successful graduates of the Leave No Trace Master Educator Course are qualified to offer both the Leave No Trace Trainer Courses as well as Awareness Workshops.
