

# Commissioner Service Award



Complete Youth Protection Training and register as any type of commissioner to receive the circular Commissioner Service Award patch. Individual segments are then earned by completing the requirements in each category. The approving signature and date are completed by the supervising commissioner such as the Council Commissioner for ACCs, ACCs for District Commissioners, DC for ADCs, ADCs for a UCs or RTCs, etc.
